Make sure you have a blending family of at least two colors, Black or Special Black Copic Sketch, Copic .5 Multi liner, Circle Templates 1 Small and 1 Large, HB pencil (mechanical works as well), Soft white eraser, White and stardust Gel Pens, Black and White Sharpie water based paint pen fine or extra fine, Scissors, Heat gun, Paintbrushes 1" flat and either a #10 or #12 flat, 12X12 Scrapbook paper at least 2 coordinating sheets, Craft Sheet, Optional: Embellishments of any kind Flowers... etc.
