We'll be using the Tim Holtz Decorative Strip to coordinate the paper lace as well as the Tattered Pinecone die to create your "pinecone" roses for this project. We'll also use pieces from Idea-ology Product line. **Supplies to Bring:** Paper Trimmer, Precision Scissors, Scoring tool, Bone Folder, (we will also have one in class) Pencil and Eraser, Ruler, small bottle of Mod Podge (available at Whim So Doodle) and paint brush, Adhesive: redline tape or score tape and glossy accents. Bring a little snack if you like as this is a 3 hour class. Note: Kits will be available with written directions and pictures.
